The Saga of Police Vetting

Lately I have been much occupied with the chasing up of outstanding paperwork for leaders and as you can guess I would much rather be spending my time either supporting and resourcing leaders in existing Units or prospecting for new Units.

Currently I am waiting on forms from 37 leaders in 13 Units. Most Police Vetting Consent forms I receive I need to return, usually because the guidelines have not been read and there is either no ID, or only one ID or the ID has not been verified correctly.



Why do I bother? You may well ask. We advertise that the leaders in IFG Units are endorsed by the church and are Police Vetted so I need to take this seriously and ensure compliances are met.

Maybe there is light at the end of the tunnel however as we have again requested that GBNZ allow the Police Vetting to be done by the church. This would align with the policy that BB ICONZ has recently introduced. We understand the frustration for churches with both ICONZ and IFG who are dealing with two different processes.

Change to Delivery Times for Badges

The following message was received from Fiona our badge supplier:

Due to our increased workload over the last 6 months or so as of 1 July 2017 please add an extra 5 working days onto what the arrangement is at the moment for fulfilling badge orders.

Over the last 6 months or so we have found it necessary to extend the time lines out for all jobs (including badge orders).

We always endeavour to stay within our time line but in some cases this just is not possible (of course if it is possible orders may be earlier than this).
