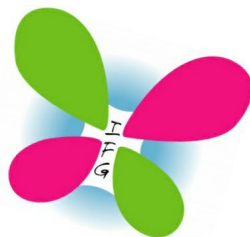

## A Message From Chris

Last month I spent a week in Prince Edward Island. My mother gave me a copy of the book "Anne of Green Gables" for my 11<sup>th</sup> birthday and ever since then I have thought it sounded like a nice place to visit. (PEI is one of the maritime provinces of Canada, next to Nova Scotia). I admit to being a little apprehensive, being a lady of "mature years" travelling all that way on my own, and just before I left the "Verse of the Day" that popped into my inbox read:

**Even to your old age and grey hairs  
I am he, I am he who will sustain you.  
I have made you and I will carry you;  
I will sustain you and I will rescue you.**

Oh dear, what am I going to have to be rescued from I wondered. However, I held this verse close during the times when my flights had been overbooked and I was not sure I would get a seat, the times when the flights had to sit in a holding pattern above an airport while my next flight was loading, and the time when my bag had to come from another terminal (it takes an hour) and my flight closed in twenty minutes. Well, all these situations worked out all right so I thought I should keep this verse for future reference. Now where was it in the Bible? I remember Isaiah, but what chapter and what verse and how could I remember them. Hmm - Chapter 46.

That's easy, I was born in 1946. Verse 4? I was born in the 4<sup>th</sup> month. How's that for a personalised message? "All the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be". Psalm 139 v. 16
