Caps

We have received a query about caps. Are they a compulsory part of the uniform?

Some leaders find the caps get in the way when doing activities/ caps get left lying around/ caps do not fit within the budget.



There were three main reasons for electing to make caps available as part of the IFG uniform.

- 1. ICONZ have a cap and very distinctive it is too.
- 2. We wanted to look distinctive as well.
